What to Know - What to Pack

Come to the St. Francis parking lot on Friday at 6:00 PM with your gear.

Southeast corner of 3rd and Jefferson

Bring the fee

- \$20 for trips that Troop 146 organizes

- \$xx for special events where the organizer sets the fee

- If you bring a check, make it out to "Norman Kasser"

We'll pack the cars and leave as quickly as we can, no later than 6:30 PM

We should return to the same parking lot on Sun around 3:00 PM

Be sure to eat supper before you come.

Things you'll need:

- Scout uniform

- Scout Handbook

- Knife, fork, & spoon

- Sleeping bag and sleeping pad

- Flashlight

- Water bottle

- Change of clothes

- Extra socks

- "Toiletry items" (toothbrush and paste, comb, etc.)

- Sneakers are OK, boots are better

- Use a backpack for your gear if you own one

- Prescription drugs (give them to the Scoutmaster)

- Note that there are no showers or other bathing facilities

- In order to reduce plastic trash, please bring your own "mess kit" items:

 - Plate, bowl, cup, knife, fork, spoon

Check the weather report for rain, if so:

- Rain jacket or poncho

- (We cancel only when driving is hazardous or severe lightning is predicted)

Check the weather report for cold, if so:

- Gloves

- Hat

- Sweater and jacket

Please leave behind:

- PlayStations (and the like)

- Cell phones

- Sheath knives
